
- In your 18 x 24" drawing pad, create a light pencil grid of nine 3 x 3" evenly spaced squares. Space the squares at least 1" from each other, and center them in your drawing pad.
- 2) Referring to the texture pattern experiments you made in your sketchbook, choose nine texture patterns to fill the nine squares, one per square. As you select, try viewing your sketchbook from a distance to see which of your experiments is most successful at close range and when you step back 4-5 feet. Try to choose those that begin to read as a solid value when viewed from a distance, and look for a range of values including darker and lighter patterns.



3) Use black fine-tipped pen to fill each square with a distinct, evenly rendered texture pattern. You should end up with a range of values among your nine texture patterns.
